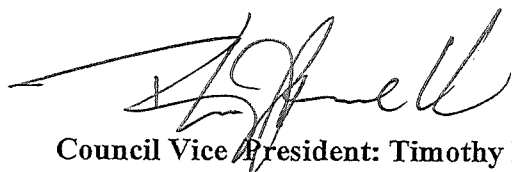
CRAWFORD CENTER/ORA LIAISON REPORT:
